A Path Through Strange Places

"Teach me Your way, O Lord, that I may walk in Your truth; unite my heart to fear Your name." - Psalm 86:11

Eastern Hills, we are indeed walking through strange places these days. But here is a truth we can carry with great certainty - it really doesn't matter how strange the place is in which we walk, so long as we can see the path ahead. And, church, let me stress, the path has never, never been hidden from us.

King David walked through many strange places, found himself in many impossibly difficult situations, but he held tightly to this truth. When he was pressed by his enenmies on all sides, he remembered God's path. He cried out, "Teach me Your way, that I may walk in Your truth." In this simple request David was reminded that he need not fear anything outside of God's path, that there is only one worthy fear in this world, that is the fear of the Lord - "unite my heart to fear Your name"

Do you see it? When your heart is trained to fear the Lord, His path lays ever before you. Of course, this is the kind of fear that draws you toward the Lord rather than away from Him. This is a fear that says, "I will forsake all in this strange world that tries to pull me from You." It is this kind of righteous fear of the Lord that illumines His path before us and keeps us from straying off into the strange world that surrounds us. Keep in mind, we cannot see the end of the path from where we stand. In fact, we may not see more than a step or two ahead, but what we do see is certain! Those of us who have our hearts united to the Lord see God's way, God's truth, God's life ahead, just as Christ promised (John 14:6). Church, praise God with me in that fact!

Make no mistake, we are still in strange places. Eastern Hills has a lot to work through. We will not get through our difficulties by pretending like they don't exist. No worries, though. God's path is not hidden. We unite our hearts to Him. We walk, one foot in front of the other, handling issues as they come, having hard conversations as they come, accepting mercies as they come, rejoicing in victories as they come. We take the next step and we, in faith, continue to follow God's path wherever it leads us. As the saying goes, "We do the next right thing." So, let us, as a congregation, pray as David prayed, "Teach me Your way, O Lord, that I may walk in Your truth; unite my heart to fear Your name." And may the Lord Jesus Christ be glorified, Eastern Hills, in every step we take.
