



Mission Tbilisi Georgia - Sartichala Baptist Church

This past week I had the opportunity to demonstrate what being kingdom focused means. This experience was not in Montgomery or in the United States. It was halfway around the world and the work was not what I do every day. Seven guys from four different churches traveled to the Country of Georgia to work with two IMB Missionaries and one Georgian Baptist Missionary to assist a small church in Tbilisi Georgia. With the help of the IMB and the Georgian Baptist Convention, Sartichala Baptist Church is building a new place to worship. They are currently worshipping in a building that is around 1,000 square feet. The new building that they are building is approximately 4,600 square feet. This building will give this church a place where they can grow together and reach people in that area for Christ

Once we arrived in Tbilisi our first engagement was to attend worship with our host church. Though our backgrounds and our language were different we were united by our worship. I had the privilege to deliver a sermon during this time of worship. Following the service, they provided lunch for us, and this gave us the opportunity to experience and hear the history of this church. Sunday afternoon we had the opportunity to see the countryside and experience the sights of Georgia.

Our work week began on Monday. Our task was to build the foundation for the new sanctuary. We mixed the concrete, poured the footers, and laid the blocks for the foundation for the new building. They fed us lunch and dinner at the job site each day. They were wonderful hosts, and we were fed well. The hotel where we stayed was about an hour drive from the job site. By Thursday afternoon we had completed our task on the foundation and had a nice dinner with the Missionaries in Tbilisi.

Friday was a day to tour the city. Tbilisi is the capital of the country of Georgia. Its cobblestoned old town reflects a long, complicated history, with periods under Persian and Russian rule. Its diverse architecture encompasses Eastern Orthodox churches, ornate art nouveau buildings and Soviet Modernist structures. Looming over it all is Narikala, a reconstructed 4th century fortress, and Kartlis Deda, an iconic Statue of the "Mother of Georgia."

On Saturday we began our trip back home. We boarded our plane at 2 a.m. and we arrived in Atlanta, Georgia (the other Georgia) at 4 p.m. Considering the 8-hour time difference, we were in the airport or on a plane for 22 hours. We were glad to be home. Thank you for being a church that believes in missions. Thank you for being a church that gives to missions and thank you for allowing me to be a part of this mission project that will be a tool to share the gospel of Christ with many people in the years to come.


