Thank you for your kindness in being a part of our Expedition support team. God gave our team opportunities to share the Gospel with Sri Lankan people and to help open more doors for the harvest workers that live there. We learned and used different tools for explaining Creation to Christ and why Jesus came. Then we went out and practiced using these tools. There were youth groups and kids from a few churches that we did training with as well. On two days of our trip, our team divided into two groups and went to do service projects. One group painted and cleaned a safe house. The group we were in painted a house church.

Weitu – My favorite part was being hands-on. I experienced the culture of the Sri Lankan people and their everyday lives. My teammate had prayed that God would give her someone to talk to that had gone through a similar life struggle, and He did. My teammate was able to share her story and she and I were able to share the Gospel with this college age girl that decided to give her life to Jesus. We left her with a Bible and a contact of someone who was there. Please pray for this college age girl to have courage to meet up with the contact.

Toby – In this whole experience, my favorite part was also being hands-on. I had opportunity to be a part of leading one of the Creation to Christ trainings with a youth group. I like being able to have various tools to share the Gospel and then go out and talk to the Sri Lankan people. God taught me to trust Him.

We had many unique experiences such as going into a mosque, going into two temples, seeing soldiers with guns guard one of the temples, watching monkeys climb the wires around our hotel and stealing our stuff, taking trains to travel to another part of the country, and going to a sea turtle sanctuary. Through all these experiences, we grew in unity with our team and in confidence of sharing the Gospel. We appreciate your financial gift and prayers for our Expedition team and our summer.

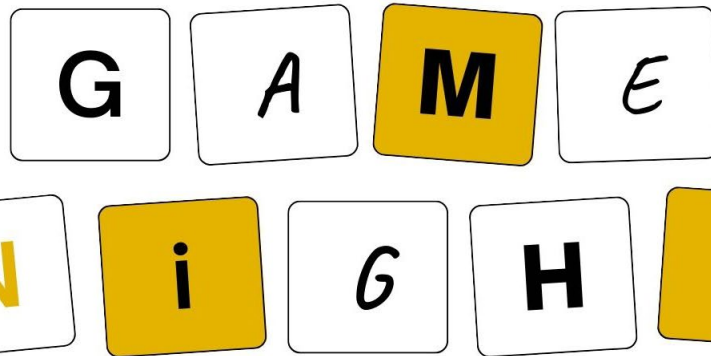

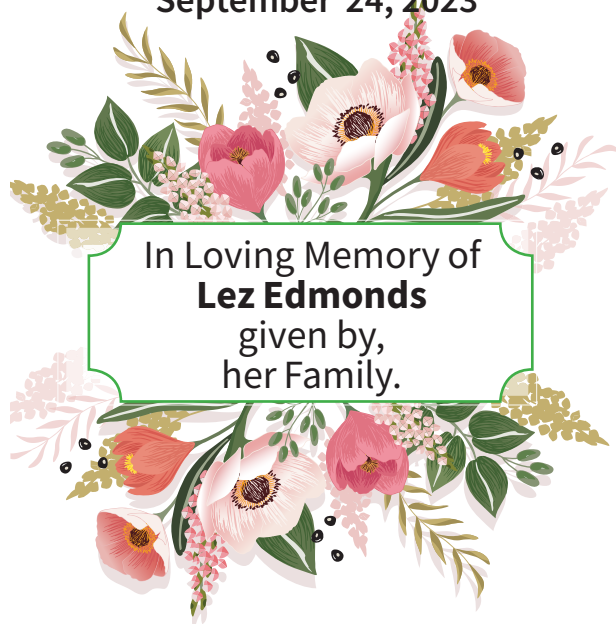
