

One of the things that I remember growing up is watching a movie called "The Legend of the Candy Cane." I always knew candy canes became popular around the holidays, but who really knows why? It's because they are a reminder to us of what Christmas is really about.

- When flipped upside-down, the candy cane makes the letter "J" to remind us that Jesus is the reason we celebrate Christmas. Without Him, there would be no cause for celebration.
- A candy cane is a hard candy. Some say it is as hard as a rock, similar to the rock we as believers should build our life on.
- The red on the candy cane reminds us of the blood that was shed on the cross on our behalf. It is a reminder of what promise was fulfilled by Jesus' birth.
- The white stripe reminds us of how perfect and blameless Jesus was in His time on this earth.
- The cane reminds us of a staff that shepherds use.
 We learn that Jesus is our good shepherd in Psalm
- The stripes remind us of Jesus' suffering and death.

Suffering and death do not exactly seem like reasons to be celebrating. It is not that we celebrate because of his death, we celebrate because of His life. Because of his life, death, and resurrection, we as believers are no longer on the hook for our sin. That is cause for celebration!

Church, as we begin eating candy canes, singing Christmas carols, setting up nativity scenes, and getting caught up in the hustle and bustle that this season brings, my hope is that you will slow down and be reminded of why we celebrate this season. My prayer is that as we remember the cause of celebration, we welcome others to take part in the celebration as well by inviting them to know why we celebrate.
