Serving in Love

"For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." — Mark 10:45, NIV

It is an unfortunate truth that people are often self-centered and form habits that serve themselves, sometimes even at the cost of others. This is due to our sinful nature that convinces us that serving ourselves is what is best and will make us happiest. However, as Christians, we are called to live differently, not like the rest of the world. Instead of looking to serve ourselves, we should look to serve Jesus Christ foremost as well as others.

Jesus is the perfect example of service towards others. He came to the world and rather than be served by others he himself served others with kindness and humility. From healing those who were sick or possessed and washing the disciple's feet to dying a gruesome death on the cross, Jesus shows us what real love and the heart of a servant truly looks like.

Eastern Hills is a church that serves others. Everywhere you turn our church is reaching out to help those in need and less fortunate. This past weekend we served our community with a food distribution on Saturday. We distributed over 6,000 pounds of groceries to those in need. We started giving out food at 10:00 a.m. and some were in line as early as 2:00 a.m. We were blessed with over 25 volunteers that helped get the food ready and distributed the food. We could not do this ministry without committed volunteers each month. Our food distribution is always on the third Saturday of each month.

Last week we had another group of volunteers that gathered to prepare plastic bags for weaving the sleeping mats for the homeless. We had over 20 volunteers from EHBC and 8 from other churches gathered to fold 2700 bags in preparation for cutting and weaving the mats. This could not be done without committed volunteers.

February is one of our months to provide food for Love Loud Montgomery. We pack the pantry for our Montgomery Baptist Association's ministry at Love Loud Montgomery. This ministry distributes this food to needy families in our community every Monday and Wednesday. We are collecting food through February 28.

"You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love." — Galatians 5:13, NIV

Serving others involves more than simply our actions. Rather, it involves our hearts and attitudes towards each other while we are serving; it involves love. Once again, we can look to Jesus as an example for this. He did not serve begrudgingly but instead showed true humility and love while he helped people from different backgrounds and social standings.

These are only a few of the ways that our church reaches out to our community and serves. I hope that you will find a way to be involved in Serving through Eastern Hills. Here are some ways that you can be involved.
