# **Ancient Words That Transform Lives**

Proverbs 29:18 is a well-known passage that God brought to mind recently.

"Where there is no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he." (KJV).

"Where there is no revelation, people cast off restraint: but blessed is the one who heeds wisdom's instruction." (NIV)

"When people do not accept divine guidance, they run wild. But whoever obeys the law is joyful." (NLT)

I read several commentaries on this passage. One that stood out, the *Cambridge Bible for Schools and Colleges*, had the following.

The vision is the actual contact between God and the human spirit, which is the necessary condition of any direct revelation; the law is the recorded result of such a revelation, either passed from mouth to mouth by tradition or written permanently in a book....'Where there is no living revelation, no perceived contact between man and God, there the bonds which hold society together are relaxed and broken; but he that holds by the revelation that has been given, obeying the law, so far as it has been presented to him, happy is he.'

The New Living Translation says it well, "When people do not accept divine guidance, they run wild." Doesn't that typify our nation today? Even in the Bible Belt we have drifted from our centeredness in Christ to a substitutionary existence. We have substituted other things, many of them good things, for the best thing – a life controlled and guided by Jesus Christ. When we allow God given blessings (leisure, jobs, financial security, family, sporting events, or the arts) to come between us and our worship we are headed for trouble. We must safeguard our time and resources to maintain a God honoring lifestyle.

A modern worship hymn written by Lynn Deshazo points to a truth we need to rediscover if we hope to turn the tide and recapture something we have lost.

Holy words of our faith handed down to this age, came to us through sacrifice, O heed the ancient words of Christ.


Holy words long preserved for our walk in this world, they resound with God's own heart. O let the ancient words impart.

Ancient words, ever true, changing me and changing you; We have come with open hearts, O let the ancient words impart.

We not only need to read God's Word, but we also need to allow His Word to change us. Through weekly Bible study and corporate worship, and our own private study, we learn about God's heart and nature. As the Holy Spirit uses these words, and we allow them to transform our nature, we become imitators of Christ.

"Be imitators of God, therefore, as dearly loved children and live a life of love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God." (Ephesians 5:1-2).




