### DON'T GIVE UP BEFORE THE MIRACLE HAPPENS.

In John 11 we find the story of Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead. If you read the chapter in its entirety a multifaceted picture is revealed...a picture of hope, then remorse, maybe regret, disappointment, and even anger. For you see Mary and Martha's brother lay sick. The passage tells us Mary was the one who had poured perfume on the feet of Jesus and wiped them with her hair (vs.2). These sisters had sent word to Jesus that their brother Lazarus was very sick. They desperately needed him without delay.

However, Jesus stayed where He was. Apparently, as was revealed at the close of chapter 10, many were coming to faith in Jesus and so Jesus stayed where He was another couple of days. By the time Jesus arrived in Bethany, Lazarus was dead. He had been dead for 4 days! When Martha heard Jesus was close by she went out to greet him, but Mary stayed at home. There is a beautiful and honest interchange between Martha and Jesus in verses 21-27. In my understanding of the text, she moved from blaming Jesus for being late in coming, to an understanding that He was the Christ, the Son of God and could do anything. I wonder if she would have had the depth of understanding of Jesus' authority if He had come before Lazarus died.

In verses 28-35 we see how Martha went back to the house where Mary was and told her that she had seen Jesus, and He was asking for Mary (vs. 28). Mary went to Jesus and fell at His feet weeping and said, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died." Jesus was moved with compassion for Mary and He wept (vs. 35). Jesus wept! He cared for these sisters deeply and for Lazarus. He understood their pain.

As you know, Jesus went to the tomb and raised Lazarus from the dead. As a result, many people came to faith in Him (vs. 45). In retrospect we realize why Jesus waited to go to Bethany, or at least the major reason why. It was to reveal His ultimate power over death. The act of raising Lazarus from the dead showed He had to be the Messiah.

There are times in our lives when it seems Jesus is distant. Possibly He has tarried a bit too long in answering our prayers or has been silent in the deepest pit of our pain, depression, grief, or loss. We wonder – why? Why did He not come earlier? Why has he not come to my aid in the middle of this great emergency? Has He forgotten me? Was I not as close to Him as I thought I was? Does He love me? Why?

Then when He answers, sometimes our understanding of why He delayed becomes evident. At other times the reason for His delay or silence is not revealed, and like Job we are left with

questions for a long season. However, ultimately God is faithful and whether we understand it here or when we see Him in Heaven, the victory is His! It will all be worth it!

As a church, we have had our struggles. However, many have remained faithful. Now, we stand on the precipice of a new start. I believe God is at work in our midst! He has brought new people into our church family in recent days, some through Believers Baptism and other believers joining us in our calling to reach our community for Christ.
