We are blessed with a church that is a *Serving Church*. There are so many ways I see each week where people are serving others through the ministries of our church. Recently EHBC has come along side with Flatline Church to minister and support the entire athletic program at Percy Julian High School. Thus far, we have served over four hundred pre-game meals and presented the gospel message and a talk about hard issues they each face. Prayer cards are filled out and brought back, distributed, and prayed over. We feel that they believe in the power of prayer and have sincere requests and expectations: "Pray for my anger issues," two weeks later, "my anger issues are resolved." "Pray for my aunt who lost her son to suicide." "Pray that all the people around me will have my back all the time." "I pray that my relationship lasts forever." "Pray for me and my family and that they keep me on the right path." Coaches and support staff also submit prayer cards. Each athlete, coach and support person will receive a Student Apologetics Bible. Last Friday eight athletes submitted their name and number to request a mentor. Please pray for Dewayne Rembert, DeAndre Burns and our EHBC team as we seek to support these individuals and serve the Lord. There will be over forty-five meals served this school year. Another Service opportunity for EHBC is this coming weekend. This is our food distribution week. 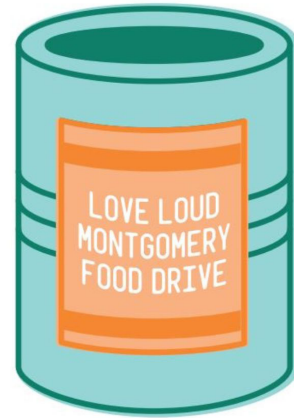
