

The same is true when it comes to our spiritual walk. I believe God would rather have consistent faithfulness than someone who puts on impressive displays of spiritual vitality, but only from time to time. Part of that faithfulness that God desires is a consistent commitment to the local church.

Being a church member is not just about having your name on a role but involves making a meaningful commitment to fellow church members and the life of the church. In my monthly articles, I have been writing about what it means to be a faithful church member. Last week, we discovered the importance of regularly gathering as a whole church congregation for worship. This week, we look smaller and will take note of the importance of personal connections in smaller groups within the church body.

The most natural environment to find such connections is within a Sunday School class.

In Sunday School, we connect with others while connecting with God through studying His Word. Healthy Sunday School classes spend time getting to know one another outside of the class and give special attention to those in the group who are not as well known. They pray for and care for one another when they are sick or hurting. They rejoice with one another and grieve with one another. They encourage one another in their spiritual walk outside the classroom and persistently share the Gospel with those that may have never been saved, gently calling those struggling in sin to repentance and restoration. They look for opportunities to serve with one another and support what God is doing at their church. In short, they walk through life together.

Without those connections, church members risk going unnoticed when they need support the most. In fact, over time, most will drift away from the church entirely, feeling dissatisfied and isolated because they have withheld themselves from the great benefits of the fellowship

If you don't regularly attend Sunday School, I would encourage you to make that commitment a priority in your life.

If you are already connected in a Sunday School class or you have found yourself leading one, I encourage you to encourage your group to consider how you can foster better and deeper connections while constantly searching for ways to assimilate new unconnected people into the fold.
