ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION

Congratulations to Susan Sessions who completes 21 years as Pianist, May 9, 2025! For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and give his life a ransom for many (Mark 10:45 ESV).

In my monthly Messenger articles, I have been describing what it looks like to be a faithful church member. Faithful church members: gather, connect, grow, serve, build, pray, and give. As we dive into each of these seven attributes, my hope is that you would take some time to reflect on your current involvement in the local Body of Christ and prayerfully consider how you might take deeper steps of commitment in certain areas for your growth, for the church's good, and for God's glory.

This month, we will see how faithful church members serve. Jesus is our example of service. From humbling Himself in His incarnation, to His compassionate care of the hurting, overlooked, and often despised, to submitting to death on the cross for our redemption, Jesus is the ultimate model of service. Before the last supper, on the eve of His sacrifice, Jesus gathered His disciples and performed one of the most menial acts of service possible. He, the Son of God, washed His disciple's feet. He then instructed His followers, *If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet (John 13:14 ESV).*

Those who follow Christ must serve as Christ served. Another time, in response to His disciples bickering over who might be worthy of being elevated to positions of honor and authority in the Kingdom, Christ admonished them saying, ...whoever would be great among you must be your servant, and whoever would be first among you must be slave of all (Mark 10:43b-44 ESV).

As followers of Christ, faithful church members serve the church as Christ served His disciples and serve the church as Christ served the world. We serve the church as Christ served the disciples by using our gifts, talents, abilities, passions, and opportunities to build up the Body of Christ and help the church accomplish it's God given mission. Paul wrote, *And he gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ (Ephesians 4:11-12 ESV).* Peter adds, *As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace (1 Peter 4:10 ESV).*

Faithful church members see the mission of church and the needs of the church and seek opportunities to get to work, serving whenever possible. Faithful church members also serve as the church wherever they go and in whatever they do to demonstrate the love of God in their community and neighborhoods, earning opportunities to share the Gospel. Service is not seasonal but a lifestyle and an act of worship. Paul wrote, *Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward. You are serving the Lord Christ" (Colossians 3:23-24 ESV).* Our church is truly a serving church. We are blessed with many men, women, and young people who are devoted to service and many opportunities for you to get more involved.

Three ways for you to find opportunities to serve:

- Read The Messenger to see what is going on and how you might pitch in.
- 2. Talk to a staff member, a Sunday School teacher, or someone involved in areas where you might be interested in serving. Don't wait to be asked to serve. Ask how you can be of help!
- Pray and ask God for opportunities to serve as the church each day. God may be calling you to begin a ministry or be more faithful as you encounter those who have needs or just need the Lord.


