PRAYER – THE KEY!

I enjoy gardening. Every year is different. Each year presents its own unique challenges and surprises, some of which are welcome and others a disappointment. Whatever comes is always a visual illustration of God's creativeness and infinite blessings!

Recently I have been talking with my brother who is also a gardener. He and I exchange bragging rights about our gardens' progress, share gardening tips, and lament over the lack of rain, too much rain, disease, insect infestation, and the like. I mentioned to him about the yellowed leaves of my Zipper Cream Peas. At that time, we were getting an excessive amount of rain. He speculated that the excess rain could have caused fungus. I sprayed them with a fungal spray. The jury is still out on whether this will do the trick and restore them to a healthy green color.

In our conversation about the peas my brother recounted how one year, when his peas did not produce very well due to a fungus, he plowed them under. Later he noticed a great number of volunteer pea plants sprouting. He allowed them to grow, and, in the end, they produced bountifully. The peas he tried to cultivate yielded a small crop, but the "volunteers" yielded a bumper crop.

I think there is a lesson here we can learn. Sometimes in the church we work hard to cultivate and persuade people to volunteer to fill various roles with little results. We announce, persuade, cajole, and practically beg with little results. Exhaustion and disappointment ensue, and we PRAY. (Maybe we should have started with prayer.) Then, seemingly out of nowhere, volunteers appear, and many times these volunteers bring fresh ideas and a God-given call to the ministry we had been missing.

Proverbs 16:3 states, "Commit your work to the Lord, and your plans will be established." One commentary I read on this passage stated. "This verse encourages individuals to trust in God's guidance and wisdom when making plans, implying that aligning one's actions with God's will leads to success. It's a call to seek God's input and approval before pursuing endeavors, rather than making plans in isolation and then asking for His blessing."

All to often we make our plans then ask God to put His stamp of approval on it and thus bless it. Prayer should precede the planning as we seek God's direction. Sometimes our "planting" is done in our strength rather than allowing God's Holy Spirit to work and bring His desired results.

"Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding, in all your ways acknowledge Him and He will direct your path." Proverbs 3:5-6.
