When my girls were little and in Girl Scouts, it started out as something for Emily to do when I was homeschooling her in second grade. She was able to make friends and do something apart from me. When Sarah Grace wanted to do it as well, I became the Daisy Leader since our troop didn't have that age and she and other kindergarten through first-grade girls could join. It was something fun that I could do with my girls.

As they got older and earned badges, I realized that the girls in our troop didn't know how to do simple things most of us learned from our mother, grandmother, or in Home Economics class in school. That is when I knew that God had put me in this position to pour into these girls and teach them skills they would be able to use the rest of their lives. I remember teaching Emily and her group of middle school aged girls how to sew! These girls had never used a sewing machine or done anything like that before. It was a challenge, but they learned to pick out fabric and the notions needed, cut the pattern and fabric, pin and then sew the garment. In the end, the girls had made enough pillow-case dresses to send to an orphanage in Africa. They were so excited when they received pictures of the girls wearing the dresses they made.

You can do the same thing here at our church when you help with Worship Care, teach a Sunday School class, or mentor a new believer, you pour love into our children and youth. You can guide them on how to study their Bible and grow in their knowledge and love of Jesus.

Think back to when you were young or a new Christian. You can probably think of one or more people that have had an impact on your life. They may have been a special teacher, helped with the children or youth, or maybe you met them when you first came to the church, and they made you feel welcome. They took an interest in you.

After getting married, my church had a discipleship class for newly married ladies. It was based on Titus 2:3-5 and the teacher shared what she had learned over the years as a wife and mother. She taught things like how to love your husband and children, plan a meal on a budget, plan meals for the week, items to keep in your pantry for pop-in guests, recipes and many other things.

How can we as adults pour into our children and teenagers to make a Kingdom impact on future generations? If you don't know of a way to help, then ask me or a staff member and we can help you get plugged in. God gives each of us different gifts so we can use them to further His Kingdom. First Peter 4:10 says, "*As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace.*"

We all have knowledge and experience we can use to help younger generations. If you and I don't help mentor and be a positive Christian role model who will?
