### A Father's Faith, A Son's Foundation

"The righteous who walks in his integrity—blessed are his children after him!" — Proverbs 20:7 ESV

Some of the strongest sermons are never preached from a pulpit. They're lived out in the quiet, steady faith of a father.

My father was a teacher and a school administrator by profession and my high school Principal. He was not one who wanted the spotlight, but his influence was great. He taught me so much by the way he lived out his faith and his life spoke volumes. He didn't just talk about trusting God—he showed me how to trust Him when money was tight, when health failed, when life didn't go as planned. His faith wasn't flashy, but it was firm. I am grateful for a church family that stands beside each other when we are struggling. The past weeks have been difficult for our family, and I am so thankful to be a part of this family of faith. Thank you for your encouragement, your cards and messages, and your prayers. They have carried us through the past week as we celebrated his life. Our hearts were broken but we also rejoice as he is with the Lord who he has served so faithfully.




