Last weekend I had the ultimate privilege of standing beside my best friend as she married the love of her life. Growing up, I've always loved weddings. They are a fun time of celebration with the people you love. Watching her tie the knot really made me reflect on what a beautiful picture that marriage is. It is a perfect reflection of Christ's love for the church - His church. I remember as a child wondering why Scripture referred to Christians as "the bride of Christ."

I think it starts with the pursuit. Just as a groom pursues his bride, Christ pursues His church. I remember when my best friend, Gracie, and her now husband, David, began dating. They didn't exactly live close together so it meant a lot of long drives and even more long phone calls. Their relationship was far from convenient, yet David pursued Gracie because of his love for her. God's love for us required a very public and uncomfortable death on a cross, yet Jesus still pursued His church.

Traditionally once a couple is ready to take the step from dating to being engaged, the man asks for the woman's hand in marriage. Oftentimes when this happens, the groom experiences fear of being rejected. The offer to spend their lives together is a thrilling offer, but the man has to first put himself in a place that the woman can either accept or reject him. Jesus hung on a cross, knowing that there will be people who reject him. Just like the groom has to put himself on the line and risk being rejected, Jesus knew that the union of Christ and His church was too sweet to let rejection stand in the way.

Another older wedding tradition is that the wedding typically happens around the bride's home and family. In our walk with Christ, we as believers just have to believe that Jesus is the Son of God and that he saved us. In layman's terms, Jesus did all of the "hard work." Jesus came to earth to meet us where we are, just like the groom comes to the bride to meet her where she is, marry her, and to take her home with him.


Ephesians 5:25-32 gives us this picture when it says, "Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word, and to present her to himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless. In this same way, husbands ought to love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself. After all, no one ever hated their own body, but they feed and care for their body, just as Christ does the church—for we are members of his body. 'For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh.' This is a profound mystery—but I am talking about Christ and the church."

Although I'm not married, I've heard it said multiple times that marriage is one of the most sanctifying things to happen to a person. It requires selfless love, support, and care. I'm so grateful for such a beautiful picture that this marriage painted. It's a reminder of how intentional God's creation is.


