Your life's a book before their eyes; they're reading it through and through; say, does it point them to the skies, do others see Jesus in you?

(chorus) Let others see Jesus in you, let others see Jesus in you; keep telling the story, be faithful and true, let others see Jesus in you.

The hymn was written by B. B. McKinney. McKinney, born on July 22, 1886, was an educated musician and songwriter. He wrote 149 hymns and gospel songs including Wherever He Leads I'll Go, The Nail-Scarred Hand, Breathe on Me, Have Faith in God, and Let Others See Jesus in You. His career spanned many roles, including teaching at Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary's School of Sacred Music from 1919 to 1932. While teaching at Southwestern, he also served as music editor at Robert H. Coleman Company in Dallas, Texas.

In 1935, he became music editor of the Baptist Sunday School Board and later secretary of the newly formed Department of Church Music. McKinney initiated several innovative ideas while at the Sunday School Board, including the development of a Church Music Training Course, having each state institute a music secretary, beginning the publication of the Church Musician magazine, and inaugurating an annual Church Music Week at Ridgecrest Baptist Assembly.

McKinney's hymn "Let Others See Jesus in You" encourages us to be men and women of faith in word and deed. The word "integrity" comes to mind, a virtue missing from many aspects of society today. Honesty, moral uprightness, and truthfulness all describe something I am afraid we have sidelined for the sake of economic prosperity and success. The erosion has been gradual, and without reflection, might be missed completely. However, its collapse is evidenced by the rising crime rate, broken homes, political schisms, and lawlessness that abounds.

It behooves us as Christians to be ever vigilant in living out what we profess we believe if our nation, our society, can exist as it has for decades, even centuries. Our only hope for the future is found in a surrendered, wholehearted people of Christ living out the words of this great hymn.

The last stanza challenges us.

Then live for Christ both day and night, be faithful, be brave and true. And lead the lost to life and light; let others see Jesus in you.

Let Others See Jesus in You


