the Savior King promised centuries ago by the prophets, Andrew decided to follow Jesus. But before he left, he did something that would have a significant impact on the Church that Jesus would establish. He found his brother Simon and brought him to meet Jesus. Simon too would follow Christ, who would give him a new name, Peter. Peter would go on to preach at Pentecost and become a pillar of the early church. But all began when his brother invited him to meet Jesus.

This month, I am extending a new challenge to every person who considers themselves a member of Eastern Hills Baptist Church called **Operation Andrew**. This emphasis involves every church member embracing the role of “Andrew” by inviting their “Simon” to meet Jesus. Your Simon doesn’t have to be a brother. It may be another family member, a friend, a neighbor, a co-worker, or anyone else you cross paths with who doesn’t know Jesus or doesn’t have a church home. Here is what **Operation Andrew** looks like.

One of the two who heard John speak and followed Jesus was Andrew, Simon Peter’s brother. He first found his own brother Simon and said to him, “We have found the Messiah” (which means Christ). He brought him to Jesus...

John 1:40-42a

The day after he had baptized Jesus, John the Baptist once again encountered Christ and exclaimed “Behold, the Lamb of God!” When two of John’s disciples heard this profound statement, they parted from John and spent the day with Jesus to find out what was so special about this man. One of the two was a man named Andrew. Being convinced that Jesus was the Messiah, *(continued, next column)*

1. **Identify** your “Simon”
2. **Intercede** (pray) for your “Simon.”
3. **Invite** your “Simon” to join you this Easter at Eastern Hills Baptist Church in hopes that they will meet and begin following Jesus.
 - Invite cards will be available.
4. **Introduce** your “Simon” to Eastern Hills by:
 - Meeting them when they arrive.
 - Being a good host by showing them around and introducing them to people.
 - Saving them a seat next to you in Sunday School, worship, and lunch.
5. **Interact** with your “Simon” after Easter by:
 - Asking them about their experience and answering any questions they might have.
 - Sharing your story about how you became a Christian and the difference Christ makes in your life.
 - Explaining the Gospel.
 - Encouraging them to consider trusting in Christ as their Savior.
 - Inviting them to come back to church with you again.

Starting Sunday, March 1, we will be making **Operation Andrew** Commitment Cards available. On one side you will put your name as sign of committing to embracing the role of “Andrew” (the inviter). On the back, you can write the name of your “Simon” who you will invite to come to church in hopes they will meet and follow Jesus.


Once complete, we are asking you to turn in your card so it can be displayed in the Sanctuary as reminder of your commitment. (Your name will be facing outward, and your “Simon’s” name will be out of view, on the side facing the wall.)

As these commitment cards are displayed, I encourage you to pray for all the “Andrews” and all the “Simons” as we as a church embrace the challenge to bring others to the Lord!
