This week has been the Week of Prayer for North American Missions. I hope you have used the prayer guide and prayed for the missionaries who are highlighted this year. If not, get one and start on Sunday.

I grew up learning about the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering every year at Easter in my small country church. We had GA leaders who taught us about missions, giving to help others, and sharing Jesus.

Who is Annie Armstrong, and why is this offering named after her? Annie Armstrong was born in Baltimore in the late 1800s and was stirred by her friend Lottie Moon, who was serving in China. Annie wrote more than 1,000 letters mobilizing churches and individuals to pray, give, and go. She started a mission for the poor and addicted in Baltimore, was the first executive of the Woman's Missionary Union (WMU), among other things, and led a life of service and devotion to Christ. In 1934, the Home Mission Offering was renamed in her honor to encourage others to follow her sacrificial example.

- 386 million people
- 378 languages spoken
- 291 million who don't know Jesus
- 161 unreached people groups

When you see those statistics, you may think they refer to overseas missions, but they are right here in America and Canada. **"Look, I tell you, lift up your eyes, and see that the fields are white for harvest" (John 4:35).**

When Emily was in seventh grade, our youth went to Wisconsin for choir tour. They were going to be gone for ten days, and that felt longer than I thought my baby should be away. Then their executive director — like our Dr. Lance here in Alabama — came to our church on a Sunday night to share what God was doing in their area. Living in the Bible Belt, we have one church for about every 1,500 people. In Wisconsin, they have one church for about every 55,000 people. I knew right then that ten days was nothing — this was for His Kingdom.

As you pray for these missionaries, I invite you to prayerfully consider your gift to the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering. One hundred percent of your gift goes to support missionaries serving right here in North America.

Behind every statistic is a person. Behind every number is a name known and loved by God. The harvest is His. The power is His. And what a sweet privilege it is that He allows us to be part of His work.




